Some budget figures for 2014

- Turnover: 32.7 Meuro
- R&D funding (EU/Academy of Finland/Tekes...): 3.9 Meuro
- Matching funding needed: 1.1 Meuro
- CSC was the most successful large Finnish corporation in the EU's Seventh Framework Programme (FP7), 2007 - 2013, as measured in terms of the number and monetary value of projects.
- CSC was on board 27 EU projects (EUR 11.4 million)
- Main challenge for CSC in EU projects is matching funding
